Let's not get stuck in a cycle loop, we need to stop dwelling on this. Let us become one subsystem


Hurry call me baby, so we can start the next phase of our journey together. Just me and you, my green eyed girl.

- First VC 6.2 upgrade complete
  - Stay in Masterlink in short comms outages
  - True signal states reported in SCATS, control of detectors
  - Ped clearance times 1 and 2 reported (reduce SC/LC alarms)
  - RAMS (remote access management system)
- Flasher units
  - Reviewing all sites, found some don't work





# Audits and Optimisation


### SCATS Site Audits (every 6 months)

- Review history, faults
- Check volumes and alarms
- Update flexilink data
- Etc...


### Optimisation Programme (3 year rolling programme)

- Review operation against NOP (network operating plan), strategies
- Site observations, safety and performance review (including peds, cyclists, filtering)
- Focus on bus routes
- Update SCATS (cycle plans, coordination/linking, variations, SA's, calibrations, etc..)
